CHILD PICK-UP

The afterschool program ends at 5:30pm each day. If you come during class time (roughly 3:50 – 5:15 each day) we request that you look at the parent table to find where your child is and meet them at that location. When staffing allows, we will try assist in their transport from the class to the cafeteria. If you always need to pick up your child early, do not enroll them in off-site activities. Please remember, it is very important that you physically sign your child out – it helps us to make sure everyone is accounted for! For the safety of all students and staff members, when ENTERING and leaving the building please use only the back cafeteria door.

You will be charged \$10 for every 5 minutes that you are late to pick up your child. Please call or text Leigh's work cell phone if you are running late!

EXTRA CLOTHES: From time to time, accidents do happen – whether it's a surprise mud puddle on the playground, a colorful paint spill, or other... messes. **Therefore, we recommend that all students, regardless of age, have an extra change of clothes**. A gallon-sized Ziploc bag, holding at least an extra pair of socks, pants, and underwear, fits nicely in the bottom of a backpack and can stay there until needed.

COLD/MUDDY WEATHER: Students at Afterschool will be going outside for free play as much as possible, even during the cold weather months. We will follow the school policy as to when it is too cold to go outside, but otherwise we will go out. **It is very important that all children have warm clothes** – hat, gloves/mittens, boots, winter jacket, snow-pants, etc.

ACTIVITY PLACEMENT POLICY

Activity placement generally occurs on a first come, first served basis; however, we do take into consideration many other important factors. These include, but are not limited to, child and group dynamics; waiting lists from previous sessions; academic need and prior opportunities to participate in high-demand activities.

CLASS SWITCHING POLICY

Students will be required to attend their classes for the <u>first two weeks</u> of the session so that they can get a true idea of what the class is all about. Students will only be allowed to switch on the third week of classes, if there is space available.

Activity Choices

Monday

K-Club (Grade K): Kindergarten students will engage in creative, hands-on activities exploring a variety of themes, while also making new friends and learning the routines of the afterschool program.

Young Architects (Grades 1-2): Put on your thinking cap and get building! This engaging STEM activity will challenge you to use a variety of materials to create incredible structures. We can build boats that float, bridges that hold weight, Lego villages and more!

Tennis and Active Games (Grades 1-5): Join Jake from Kids on the Ball for six weeks and develop a love for tennis. The last few weeks of the session we'll play big, active gym games together!

Chess Masters (Grades 1-5): Learn to love this classic game with a Chess Master! Students will learn the rules of the games, basic tactics and strategy, as well as respect for others and good sportsmanship. All levels of experience welcome!

D.I.Y. Club (Grades 3-5): Spend the afternoon crafting creations from scratch. Guided by student interest, we might learn how to knit, crochet, hand sew and make friendship bracelets in a cozy environment.



Tuesday

K- Club (Grade K): Kindergarten students will engage in creative, hands-on activities exploring a variety of themes, while also making new friends and learning the routines of the afterschool program.

Yoga (Grades 1-2): Calm your mind, stretch your body and relax. Let's come together in a safe space to come back to our bodies and center our mind.

Crafty Kids (Grades 1-2):

Your imagination is the limit when it comes to these crazy creations! We will use paint, glue, clay, strings, wires, beads, gems found objects, you name it, its art!

From My Head Tomatoes (Grades 3-5):

Join Chef Dusty for an interactive and fun cooking class where you will get burning questions answered like; Where does kale come from? What is Kohlrabi? What temperature does water boil? We'll cook up something delicious in the big kitchen together!

Hackers Club (Grades 3-5): Do you want to learn more about hacking and cyber security? Take your computer skills to the next level and learn how to secure a website against hackers with fun challenges on HackThis!!



Wednesday

K-Club (Grade K): Kindergarten students will engage in creative, hands-on activities exploring a variety of themes, while also making new friends and learning the routines of the afterschool program.

Outdoor Adventures (Grades 1-2): Go on a scavenger hunt, build fairy houses, make giant bubbles, fly kits and be active outside this fall. What adventures can we come up with together?

Ooey Gooey Science (Grades 1-2): In this class you will explore chemical reactions that produce surprising results: your concoctions might change temperature or color, bubble, fizz, smoke, or maybe even glow!

Minecrafters (Grades 3-5): Create and explore a private world you build alongside your peers with the support of an experienced player.

Team Sports (Grades 3-5): Play kickball, soccer and basketball while learning good sportsmanship and having fun with you friends!



Thursday

K-Club (Grade K): Kindergarten students will engage in creative, hands-on activities exploring a variety of themes, while also making new friends, enjoying the beautiful fall weather and learning the routines of the afterschool program.

Move Your Body! (Grades 1-2): If you like to have fun while being active then this is the class for you! You will try various kinds of games, challenges and relay races that will get your body moving!

Minecraft (Grades 1-2): Do you love the game *Minecraft*? Wait, of course you do! In this class you will be given access to our private world. Returning players can continue to craft the world they started and new players can begin to craft, build, explore in their Minecraft world.

Ultimate Field Games (Grades 3-5): Let's get outside and enjoy the weather playing kickball, capture the flag, ultimate frisbee and more. In this class you will work on developing skills, while building teamwork and emphasizing fair play.

Park Explorers (Grades 3-5):*** Explore the great outdoors at Ethan Allen Homestead guided by an environmental educator! Students will spend nearly the whole time outside, so please bring weather appropriate clothing!

Chill Zone (Grades 1-5): Do you feel like just chilling and playing a game with a friend, reading a book, building with blocks or coloring? This is the group for you!

Students love this day because they get to choose based on how they are feeling that day!
