CALLING ALL 4 YEAR OLDS SOON TO BE KINDERGARTNERS!

It's that time of year again. Kindergarten registration for 2019-2020 school year is now open!

If you have a child who will be in kindergarten next fall, don't wait to register. We need their place saved by you otherwise you may find yourself having children in two different schools.

This year we started with two kindergarten classrooms and had to open a third because students arrived to register as school was opening and we had no more space. Parents new to school systems with their first child are often unaware that Kindergarten Registration takes place so far in advance of the fall. Some think they simply show up on the first day of school. Those whose children are going to our partner preschools are made aware that it is time to register for Kindergarten now. Unfortunately, those who don't attend preschool are less likely to get the word. **This is where I need to ask all of you to help out**.

If you know of a family that has a 4 year old who might be 5 by September 1st, please let them know that it is important to register their child now. Follow up with them - remind them. Even help them by bringing them to the school if they are unsure of how to register. Registration is on line, but if that is a problem, we can help them. What should you tell parents?

- Kindergarten registration is open and it's important to register their child early to get into the school of their choice (this is where you EES parents will of course be singing the praises of your experiences at EES).
- Tell them they can register on line by going to this link: <u>https://www.bsdvt.org/students-and-</u> <u>families/school-registration/</u> If they need help, tell them to come to the school and we'll help!
- 3. Let the parents know that they can take a tour of our school and see it for themselves.
