From the Principal's Desk

It was great having all of our students and families back this week. I know that some question not waiting until after Labor Day, but it works really well to ease into the full day weeks, first with three days, then a four day week, and finally five full days. We are still working out some kinks with the new system but overall, we are very excited about the improvements we have at EES. The new entrance is really beautiful and far more welcoming than our old lobby. As a reminder, anyone coming after 8:15 should go to the central entrance which will be the Edmunds complex main entrance.

The function of the new entrance is two-fold; to insure a secure entrance to the entire campus and to provide a truly accessible entrance. In order to be successful in providing a secure entrance, we need to have all who visit the school follow the procedures that are in place. They are really no different than in the past. At 8:15, the front door of EES on Main Street will be locked. EES faculty and staff have been instructed to direct anyone asking to enter to the main entrance

If you are coming to simply pick up your child for early dismissal, please tell our attendant (Sarah Orndorf) who you have come to pick up. She will alert the appropriate teacher to send your child to the lobby. Please wait in the lobby. It is fine to call us in advance to let us know that you will be arriving in a few minutes so that we can have your child waiting for you. We will need to physically see you in order to release your child from the school.

If you are coming for a meeting, please sign in at the reception desk and put on a visitors tag before proceeding. We must insist that no one walk through the halls without following this procedure. All faculty and staff have been instructed to stop anyone without a Visitor's tag and refer them back to the Central Reception desk.

All EES faculty and staff have been instructed to direct anyone seeking to enter the EES front door to the Edmunds Complex Main Entrance. That is also the entrance for Burlington Kids After School. These procedures are common to many institutions throughout the country. We need everyone's cooperation in following them.
