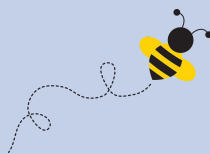

Have a relaxing Memorial Day weekend,

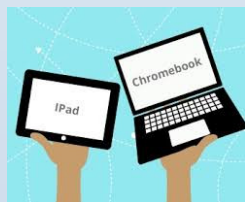

The last day for student devices to go home is June 1st. All devices, chargers and cords must be returned on June 2nd, even students who may need a device for summer programming are required to return their devices.

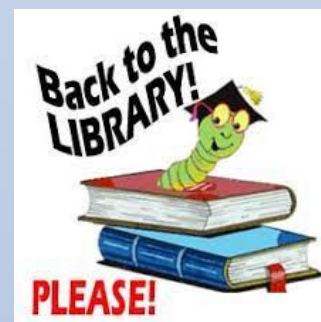
EES Spirit Day!
