<u>Drop-Off, Pick Up & Parking at Edmunds Elementary</u>

Arrival time & procedures: PTO Parking Volunteers have worked hard in the past few years to implement a program that ensures our children's safety at drop-off, while also making it as convenient as possible for parents. Please follow these rules so that everyone can safely get to the Drive-thru drop-off available in the Main Street horseshoe. To keep traffic flowing, a right turn only onto Main Street is strongly encouraged.

- No students should enter school grounds by using the South Union Street driveway.
- No parking in the Main Street horseshoe from 7:45-8:30AM.
- Do not drop students off at the back of the school!
- **DO NOT** park in the staff parking lot.
- Use the metered parking spots on Main Street if you need to park.

Please be respectful of the volunteers assisting your child and of the other families. This is a busy and hectic time of day!



Dismissal Time & Procedures

Students are dismissed at 2:50 P.M. Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday and 1:50 pm on Wednesday. Please note the following:

- Students exit through the front and side doors only.
- Students are not to use the back door due to lack of supervision.
- No parking in the Main Street horseshoe from 2:15-3:00 P.M.
- Parents/Guardians are asked to wait outside until dismissal in order to cut down on traffic in the hallways and to ensure that the students continue with their assignments.
- On early release days, all students are dismissed at 11:30 am.
